

## **Brighten Group – Saint John Regional Hospital Auxiliary Student Volunteer Award Application**

### **Eligibility Criteria**

Applicant must be between 17-25 years of age; a well-rounded individual with outstanding people skills; dedicated to the pursuit of excellence; a dedicated volunteer with a genuine desire to help others and make a difference in their lives; must be an active volunteer within Horizon Health, having accumulated a minimum of 100 hours, with at least some at the Saint John Regional Hospital; must be pursuing a post-secondary education in a health care field; must have an average grade point level of 80% or 3.0; and must be from or currently residing in the Greater Saint John area.

### **Requirements**

Please enclose the following:

- A statement explaining why you deserve consideration for a Student Volunteer award, as well as the value and impact of your volunteer experience
- Two reference letters (one of which must be from an academic instructor) placed in sealed envelopes and initialed by referees
- An official high school transcript
- An official up to date university transcript (if available)
- Your resume
- Completed application form

Completed applications must be received at the Brighten Group office no later than April 30<sup>th</sup>. Your completed application can be dropped off to the Brighten Group office, which is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Saint John Regional Hospital.
